Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District is seeking a highly motivated individual with the ability to perform a wide range of complex open space oriented project management and planning duties. Typical projects may include preparing master plans, site plans, and resource management plans to guide the use and management of District lands; directing the design and implementation of capital improvement projects such as trails, trail bridges and staging areas; conducting or overseeing studies to identify and evaluate environmental issues related to public access and natural and cultural resources; preparing applications and administering grants; preparing environmental documents as required by CEQA; and obtaining environmental permits and development permits for District projects. This position represents the District at public meetings and works with citizen's groups regarding planning and management issues.

Equivalent to a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in urban or regional planning, geography, landscape architecture, architecture, natural resource management, environmental planning or a related field. A Master's degree is desirable.

Three years of increasingly responsible planning and land use experience, preferably in parks, open space or a related field.
